

How to play: TRASH

The Card Game


Materials:

• One Deck of Cards for every Two Players

Set Up:

1. Shuffle the deck and deal out ten cards face down for each player.

Example:



Goal:

The goal of the game is turn all your face down cards up by collecting A-10

A	2	3	4	5
6	7	8	9	10

2. Place the remaining deck in the center to form a stock pile.

Gameplay:

- 1. The first player draws a card from the stock pile.
 - a. If the card is a King or Queen it is immediately discarded as "Trash" and that players turn is over.
 - b. If the card is a number (A-10) the player may remove the face down card in the designated position and replace it with the new card. (*See layout*.)
 - c. If the card is a Jack the player may replace ANY face down card as Jacks are WILD.
- 2. The removed card, in turn, may be placed in it's designated spot if the position is available and so on until a card cannot be played.
 - a. Duplicate cards become TRASH
 - b. In the event that a numbered card is drawn but a Jack is already in its designated position, the Jack may be displaced and used again in place of any face down card.
- 3. The next player can choose to draw from the stock pile or pick up the top card from the discard pile.
- 4. When a player has turned all ten cards face up, they WIN!

** Note: The 10 cards **do not** need to be of the same suit.
